1. Agenda Review – Craig moved to accept the agenda. Motion seconded by Gunter. Carried
2. Gunter moved to approve the minutes of the Executive meeting for February 21st. Motion seconded by Craig. Carried.
3. Executive Meeting follow-up items:
 - a) Try-a-ride waiver complete
 - b) Google calendar on website almost complete

4. Financial Update:

 - b) Membership
 - i. There have been 30 members to date with 2 payouts from CCN
 - ii. Issues regarding CCN – there have been difficulties obtaining PDF lists of members. Art will contact CCN to request that exec member who enter site with Admin email, can receive the members list. Some members had difficulties when registrations began but none since.
5. Website:
 - a) Various links have been added to the website. Andrew demonstrated the Google calendar and how it connects to routes planned for a specific day.
 - b) On April 24th, the Bike Tune-up Day, Andrew will spend some time demonstrating the new Website to members
 - c) Websites Requests – Art would like to see other cycling events (non KCC) on the website by using links. i.e. OCA schedule. Deb Craven would like a link to FaceBook as well as a Gallery for photos by using Dropbox
6. FaceBook update:
 - a) Deb C reported that she gets a lot of feedback from items/photos that are posted on the KCC FaceBook page
 - b) Deb would like the members of KCC to have more freedom to post on our page and will look into how this can be done.
 - c) Discuss was held regarding what information would like to be seen on the FaceBook page – upcoming rides, photos of rides
7. Rides Update:

- c) Try-a-Ride:
 - i. For each ride, forms must be completed by the ride leader with participants name and contact information. This in turn gets sent to OCA
 - ii. All road try-a-rides will start from Spokes for Folks
 - iii. There will be 12 try-a-rides for the touring group starting with the first ride on May 1st each Thursday until mid-July
 - iv. Craig will advertise the Try-a-ride in Kawartha This Week giving a link to our website for full details
8. Kawartha Lakes Classic:
 - a) Boston Pizza will sponsor the lunch for the event
 - b) Sweet Bottoms were concerned that they had not received a tax receipt from last year for their sponsorship. Gunter was able to work things out with APCH. Deb S and Gunter have decided they need to have a meeting with Zeta on what is needed for sponsors to receive tax receipts so this does not happen again.
 - c) Sponsors names are needed by the end of April so they can be printed on posters/flyers. If the contribution is >\$200 they are a sponsor, if <\$200 they are a supporter.
 - d) Anna Manson has completed the poster for the event. Once the event has been published on CCN, it can then be posted to the public
 - e) Massage chairs will be available post ride at a cost of \$10/10minutes. \$5 of the cost will go to APCH.
 - f) Mike will approach his Garneau reps regarding a display for the event.
 - g) Cable Cable & BOB FM will be advertising support
