

The Devan KM Award

The Devan KM Award is in recognition of Brian Devan, who was a long-time member of The Kawartha Cycling Club. His Kilometre achievements have been unchallenged as he has held a record of riding 25,000 km in one year. He has been an inspiration to us and as a result, we have developed this award. The trophy houses his first jersey from the Kawartha Cycling Club from 2006, when we became officially established. Brian was inspired by The Canadian Kilometer Achievement Program, an initiative of the Cycle for Fitness and Health of the CKAP Incentive Program, whereby in 2006, he achieved 10,000 km. He continued with this program in 2007; Brian achieved 15,000 km. In 2009, he achieved 25,000 km.

This year, the KCC developed this award to recognize a KCC member who rode the longest total distance in one year with us.

The Devan KM Award will be presented at our Spring Rollout meetings with the winner's name and the kilometres achieved mounted on the award's frame with an engraved plate.

Participation outline:

- You can ride a bike of your choice if it meets the requirements of our KCC [Policies](#).
- You may include riding your bike on an indoor trainer.
- For this year only the Kilometres will start May 1st, 2023, and run to December 31st, 2023. Since this is a new trophy, it will give everyone an equal chance for 2023.
- Continuing in 2024, we will cover the entire year from January 1 to December 31st.
- Kilometres will be based on each member's Strava totals as shown in "You This Year" and will be calculated from May 1st (your first 4 months of 2023 will be subtracted from the total of the year).
- You are a Kawartha Cycling Strava Club member and have joined the challenge.
- Your Kilometres must be logged in Strava.
- There will be NO manual entries allowed.
- Log in only Bike riding. Any other Strava activity like running or walking, for example, will not be included.
- There will be NO double recording allowed.
- Sharing a ride is allowed if a person's ride recorder failed.
